Trail Map

This two-sided color map of Winacka and Whispering Oaks includes trail names, length, GPS coordinates and degree of difficulty. While hiking, you'll find that each trail is marked with color-coordinated wooden posts to help

guide you. 11x17" printed copies of the map are available at each camp.



Winacka Trail Guide: Includes Meadow Trail, Eagle Peak Trail, Sunset Ridge Trail, Creek Trail, Middle Trail, Manzanita Trail, Gorge Trail, Tower Trail, Panorama Trail, Los Caballos Trail and Lakeside Trail.



Whispering Oaks Trail Guide: Includes Hobbits Turn Trail, Inspiration Point Trail, Dehr Creek Trail and Chaparral Trail.



Guide to trails between camps: Includes Coulter Trail and Winacka-Whispering Oaks Trail.



Whispering Oaks Discovery Hike

Hike up to Inspiration Point and learn to recognize native plants, using your senses to explore a new place.



Winacka Discovery Hike

Explore three ecosystems at Camp Winacka: the meadow (below the lodge), chaparral (with "tunnels" formed by the Manzanita shrubs), and oak woodland (near the flagpole and at Sunset Rocks).
